CEREBRUM ANATOMY NOTES




We know our brain consists of three main parts. Do you remember what these are called...two sound quite similar. Yes, that's right, the cereBRUM which is the largest area, the CereBELLUM underneath and the BRAIN STEM.

Today lets look into the CEREBRUM a little closer.

The cerebrum is divided into FOUR LOBES. Let's memorise this mnemonic to help us remember their names, because without our brain we wouldn't be able to taste sweet, delicious ICECREAM with...

When you think of the FRONTAL LOBE think of it as FIGURING out because this part of the Cerebrum is responsible for problem solving and planning. Also think of FUN and FASCINATING, because its also responsible for our emotions and our behavior. Also think of FOCUS because its responsible for concentration and self-awareness. Lets repeat, FUN, FASCINATING AND FOCUS IS WHAT OUR FRONTAL LOBE IS FOR!

Let's pop over to the PARIETAL Lobe now.

Any guesses what Parietal could be? OUCH!! Think of Parietal as PAIN, because this is the part of our brian that senses PAIN, aswell as TOUCH and TEMPERATURE.

Over to OCCIPITAL lobe now. Oh, I see you're thinking what this might be? Well I like to think of this as the brains OPTICIAN, responsible for interpreting our vision!

And last but not least, the TEMPORAL LOBE! When I think of the TEMPORAL Lobe, TIMES TABLES come to mind. What do we need to remember our times table... Yes that's right, we use our MEMORY, which is what the temporal lobe is responsible for. And you get someone to test you, who HEARS you read them aloud, because it's also responsible for hearing. And you have to UNDERSTAND LANGUAGE for you to memorise your timetables, another of its jobs.

and its four lobes!






